

# PERMISSION TO WET TREAT

The definition or meaning of this phrase is that the *garment will be wet-treated with water*, and the possible use of whitening agents, spot removers and any other product that may assist to improve the stained area will be used.

The effect of any of these procedures may have an effect on the garment relating to **overall lightening, possible shrinkage or change of colour** if the dye is not colourfast to water or any other form of cleaning agent. These effects we have no control over or any method of testing beforehand. Some fabrics may even change texture or surface finish.

This method is used when all *practical procedures involved in dry cleaning have been exhausted* while staying within the confines of the care label attached to the garment.

*This is the reason* we ask for your **permission** to carry out this treatment. We ask you to appreciate that we would not suggest this treatment to you unless we had been successful with the majority of garments in the past. However we cannot accept any responsibility for the outcome.
